### ACADEMICS

#### Religion

Students continue to grow in their knowledge of God and our Catholic faith as the four pillars of the Catechism of the Catholic Church: the Creed, Sacraments, Morality and Prayer are taught. The curriculum is enhanced with daily prayer, participation in weekly liturgies, rosary and participation in numerous service projects focusing on helping others.

#### Language Arts

The Language Arts program is a well-balanced program which integrates literature with the important skills of writing, spelling and phonics. The goal of our Language Arts program includes enhancing skills in reading, speaking, visualization and the writing process. Students are given both short and long term assignments that utilize all of these skills.

#### Mathematics

The Mathematics program provides the students with a variety of ways to solve problems. This approach enables our students to gain an increased knowledge of number sense which is a prerequisite for higher math. Our mathematics program aims at providing lifelong skills that will allow students to function well in an ever increasing complex technological society.

#### Social Studies

The Social Studies curriculum includes geography, history, government, citizenship, culture and current events. Our program enables students to investigate the past, discover their place in the present and understand their impact on the future. Student learning is enhanced through hands-on projects and a variety of field trips.

#### Science

The Science curriculum emphasizes inquiry. Observations, investigations, demonstrations and participating in hands-on activities are integral parts of our curriculum. Many of these lessons are taught in a cross-curricular approach.

#### Art/Music/Physical Education/Library/ Technology

Our students participate and grow in each of the above key areas, on a weekly basis. Students develop an appreciation for art while creating their own masterpieces. Musical productions are designed for each grade level and access to computers via the computer lab or classrooms allows our students to use their skills throughout all classes.

#### Standardized Testing

As a state accredited school we administer the Terra Nova Achievement Test to our students in grades two through eight. Our students consistently score higher than both the national and Archdiocese of Cincinnati averages. Our test scores reveal that our students as a whole perform above their anticipated scores, thus demonstrating that academic success is not only a priority, but also a reality at our school.
