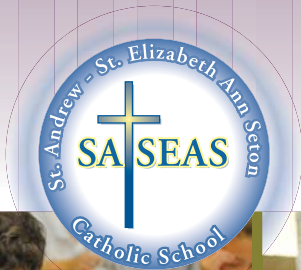

ACADEMICS

Religion

Your child will develop a deeper relationship with Christ while studying the Old Testament and experiencing the rich history of our Church. Language Arts
