Please check Miss Wethington's newsletter for homework if your child goes to her for Language Arts and Math otherwise, if your child stays with me all day, the homework will be what is listed on my newsletter. (All three rooms should have the same homework this week.) We are working on getting the first grade website back up soon.

*Meet the teacher night will be on Thursday for grades 2-5 only. Kindergarten and first grade teachers will not be there because we had an orientation.

*In Language Arts, we will be reading the stories Susie and the Bandits and The Storm. We will be working on vocabulary words, story comprehension, retelling, and summarizing. We will also review the sounds for short i and the consonants r, g, b, h, and s. We will also continue to practice writing letters and numbers correctly. We will review nouns and learn to recognize complete sentences.

*In Math, we will practice writing the numbers 3-6 correctly and work with tally marks and calendars.

*This week in Religion, we will begin chapter 2: We Believe in the Blessed Trinity. We will be thankful God sent his Son to us and understand that Jesus is God's greatest gift to us. We will continue to work on genuflecting and making the sign of the cross correctly. Please help your child with this when he/she attends Mass with you.

*In Social Studies, we will be learning about community rules and laws and discuss the consequences of breaking them. We will also learn about maps and the symbols used on map keys.

*In Health, we will be learning about our heart and lungs and their functions. We are also reviewing the 5 senses.
