*Friday will be another pajama day because we did such a great job bringing in so many items for St. Vincent DePaul. Way to Go Titans!

*In Language Arts, we will be reading The Three Wishes and Where Does Food Come From? and work on vocabulary words, story comprehension, main idea, drawing conclusions, retelling, sequence of events, and summarizing/retelling and cause/effect. We will also be reviewing the long a sound and learning the ay and ai spelling patterns for long a. We will learn how to write the months of the year, days of the week, and holidays correctly by capitalizing them. We will also learn about writing friendly letters and review different types of sentences.

*This week in Religion, we will finish up chapter 12 and begin chapter 15: We Belong to a Parish. We will identify things we do in our parish and learn how a parish joins together to celebrate God's love.

*In Science, we will begin to learn about how some solids dissolve in liquids and how some do not.

*In Social Studies, we will begin unit 4: Our Changing World. We will learn about people and schools long ago and compare how they have changed over the years. We will also look at how ways to communicate, types of transportation and tools have changed over the years as well.
