Morning Curriculum

Religion- to discover that Mary, the Mother of Jesus, loved others, to review the Hail Mary, to celebrate Mary

Reading - Blend Phonemes, Segment Phonemes, substitute phonemes, introduce new oral vocabulary, Review letters Vv and Zz, and Vv and Zz words, Introduce new high frequency words look and out, Review all high frequency words, develop listening and comprehension skills, review compare and contrast and story structure and infer/predict, practice subject - verb agreement, review writing a response to literature.

Math-to provide concrete experiences with figuring out missing numbers in equations, to introduce how to model number stories on a calculator, to introduce the use of non standard units on a pan balance, to practice math skill through math games

Social Studies - Describe how things change from day to day. Sequence events by using yesterday, today, tomorrow.

Science - To identify colors as a characteristic of matter. To discover that white light is made up of the colors we see in a rainbow

Health - to introduce the function of the brain and stomach.
