On a daily basis, children have the opportunity to experience developmentally appropriate lessons and activities.



ACADEMICS

Religion

Students will learn the basics of their Catholic Faith through Bible study, prayer, Church visits, community service projects, and the Archdiocese of Cincinnati Religion curriculum. The children will develop a personal relationship with God and share the Gospel with others.

Language Arts

Language Arts focuses on phonics, sight word recognition, writing and an appreciation of literature. Phonemic Awareness, the ability to use and manipulate oral sounds, is a prerequisite skill in learning to read and will be emphasized in the classroom. Your child will participate in activities, games and centers that will be engaging in an overall learning environment.

Mathematics

The Kindergarten mathematics program provides students with many experiences. The activities involve whole group, small group, learning centers and partner work. The program is organized into six mathematical content strands that provide a wide and balanced curriculum to include: numeration, computation, problem solving, geometry, data and algebraic thinking.

Social Studies/Science/Health

Students will learn about themselves, others, and the world around them. Hands-on activities, non-fiction books, experiments, field trips, in-school programs, films and pictures are an integral part of our program that will assist and challenge your child to explore the world.

Music/Computer/Physical Education

Your child will participate and grow in each music, computers and physical education. Your child will receive instruction from individual teaching staff who specialize in these areas.
