Be it known to all who enter here that Christ is the reason for this school. He is the unseen but ever present teacher in its classes. He is the model of its faculty and the inspiration of its students.

Dear Parents:

Please stop your children from doing the “Snow Dance”! We have already used two of our five allotments of calamity days. I have heard many questions concerning just this. In this latest state budget, the governor has put into place a reduction of the number of calamity days permitted. We are still at five for this year and it goes to three the following. Yes, there is even talk of not permitting any the year after that - meaning that every day missed is made up.

As I have mentioned in previous Titan Times, we have put together a Marketing Committee – one which has been extremely busy during these past few weeks. Our first priority is preparing for and getting the word out for Open House. I must publicly thank this group of volunteers. Without their commitment and dedication, none of this would have happened.

Thus far, the following has been accomplished: Our new website is up and running. This one will be up through Open House. After that, we will have another new website taking its place. We have designed a very impressive invitation to our Open House that will go out to 6000 households who have children anywhere from the ages of 3 to 10. The invitations will go out this week. We have also put together a “reminder” post card which will go out the weekend before Open House.

We will have two large banners with Open House information which will be hung on an overpass or placed in some other prominent location. Additionally, we have 150 to 200 yard signs advertising the Open House.

Letters will be written and distributed by students after the masses, thanking parishioners for their continued support – for without the parishes, we would have no school. At the end of mass we will also have students read a little blurb on why a Catholic education is so important to them.

We are in the process of putting together three different brochures to be passed out during open house – one for kindergarten, one for grades 1 through 5 and the third will be for the junior high campus.

And finally, we have created a Facebook advertisement targeting a very specific group of people. Every time they log onto Facebook, our ad will pop up and will link them to our website.

While all this is very good and much needed, you are still our best marketing resources. Please help us spread the word about our Open House. Encourage a friend or neighbor who may be exploring schooling for their children to come give us a look. We recognize the importance of celebrating the work and accomplishments of our current students, but it is also vital that we “sell” our school to perspective families.

I hope to see everyone tomorrow evening at our **Parent Information Night**.

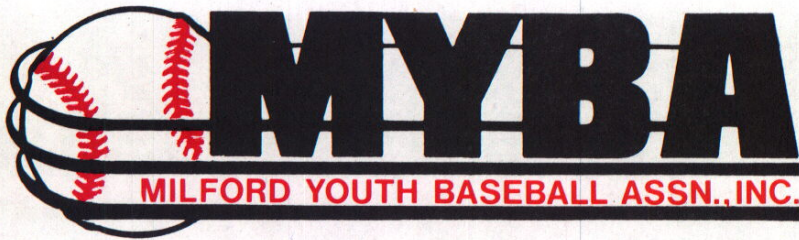

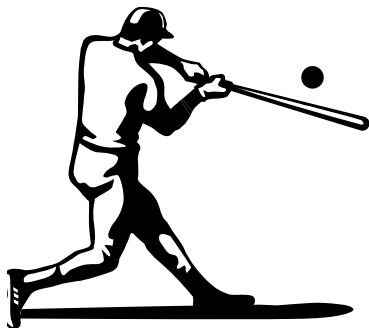
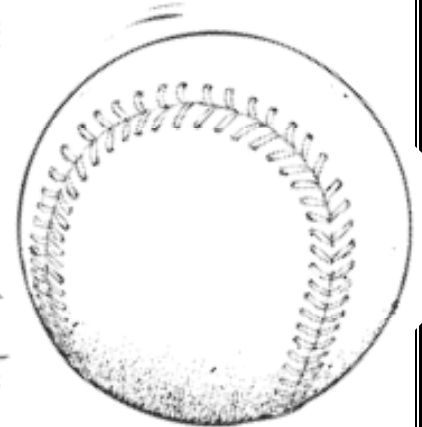
