Principal’s Update

Dr. Sasson discussed how several parochial principals in the area are meeting with state legislators to highlight our liaisons with the public schools in several areas. Calendar for 2009-2010 school year will be distributed in early March. School will be starting early, August 20, 2009 and ending early May 28, 2010 coinciding with the Milford Public School dates. The 2009-2010 school calendar is currently being created. Dr. Sasson is getting input from faculty, staff and other areas. Ultimately they will choose from three varying calendars for next year. There is a community meeting regarding Milford Main on Wed 3/11. Dr. Sasson plans on attending to represent SASEAS. Discussed issue of “sexting” at jr. high and policies at SASEAS. Dr. Sasson to include an article on the topic for parents in the Titan Times. Early dismissal on Tuesday 3/24. Teacher workshop will focus on transition from 5th to 6th grade. Current faculty are turning in their “intentions” for returning next school year. Current 2009-2010 enrollment is 60 students short of budget. 8th graders will be making vocational trips in March, boys to the seminary and girls to the convent in Walton, Ky. After 3rd quarter break, Officer Petrocelli is meeting with Jr high students to discuss scenarios requiring cautious thinking. All-school Mass will be held at Seton on Wed April 8th at 9:30 a.m.

Old Business
