

Guidelines For Remote Learning

A student will be eligible for remote learning when placed in quarantine (confirmed exposure) or isolation (confirmed positive).

Grades 6-8

- Once confirmed exposed or confirmed positive remote learning will start the next school day for the student. Please notify the school nurse of exposure or if positive.
- If students don't have all the materials they need, that is ok. Teachers will use this time to check in with the student and give any instructions.
- If the student is absent for a non COVID-19 symptom/reason, waiting to see the doctor or waiting for test results it is treated like a normal absence and missed work is picked up at the end of the day. Please call the school office to make arrangements to pick up work.

Grades 3-5

- Once confirmed exposed or confirmed positive remote learning starts on day 2 for the student, this gives the teachers 24 hours notice before starting remote learning. Please notify the school nurse of exposure or if positive.
- If the student is absent for a non COVID-19 symptom/reason, waiting to see the doctor or waiting for test results it is treated like a normal absence and missed work is picked up at the end of the day. Please call the school office to make arrangements to pick up work.

Grades K-2

- Once confirmed exposed or confirmed positive blizzard bags start on day 2 for the student, this gives the teachers 24 hours notice to gather materials for starting the blizzard bags. Please notify the school nurse of exposure or if positive.
- If the student is absent for a non COVID-19 symptom/reason, waiting to see the doctor or waiting for test results it is treated like a normal absence and missed work is picked up at the end of the day. Please call the school office to make arrangements to pick up work.

Parents-please call the attendance line each day of absence. Once quarantine or isolation is confirmed with the school you do not need to continue to call the attendance line.
